

Programming/Reentry Coordinator

Franklin County is recruiting for a Programming/Reentry Coordinator position. This position is responsible for the development and implementation of comprehensive reentry programs for individuals transitioning from incarceration back into the community. This position will work collaboratively with various stakeholders to ensure seamless coordination of services and resources to support successful reintegration and reduce recidivism rates. Work is performed under the supervision and support of the Sheriff's Office.

Requirements for this position include:

- Minimum high school diploma or equivalent
- Bachelor's or master's degree in social work, criminal justice, public administration, or a related field preferred.
- Licensed Clinician preferred.
- Previous experience working with individuals involved in the criminal justice system, preferably in a reentry or corrections setting is preferred.
- Knowledge of reentry principles, evidence-based practices, and best practices in criminal justice and social services is preferred.
- Strong organizational, planning, and project management skills.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills, with the ability to collaborate effectively with diverse stakeholders.
- Ability to work independently, prioritize tasks, and manage multiple responsibilities in a fastpaced environment.
